LONGSHOT: Race 6 - #8 Time to Travel

Coming off a layoff since April, and making his first start for trainer Troy Wismer, this full brother to multiple G1 winner Hard Not to Like has been training well over the Gulfstream main track for his return to the races. With a promising start to his career, it seems this gelding has lost his way a bit, but if he can recapture some of his back class he'll be a nice price under hot-riding Luis Saez.
