**LONGSHOT: Race 4 - #5 Hangry**

While I definitely relate to the name, I have also become a fan of the horse, as he always runs to his competition when at the right level. A late-running closer, I think the key here is that Hangry will get the pace setup that is conducive to his running style, especially since the arguably best two horses in the race are "need the lead" types. He should be able to close and grab a share if not win it.
