LONGSHOT: Race 9 - #1 Beneficiary

Stretching out in distance to two turns after a pair of sprint races, I think that this horse is getting back to his most efficient distance. In addition, the last time he ran two turns, it was against significantly tougher competition. To add further appeal, if the race does come off the turf due to weather, Beneficiary is 1-for-1 on a wet track.
