**LONGSHOT: Race 11 - #6 Barney Rebel (Ire)**

Besides having a great name, I think this gelding has a chance today to recapture some of his past turf form. Last time out, he was on a yielding turf course at Laurel where there was no chance to make up any ground. Prior to that, the race was taken off the turf. At this nine furlong distance, you need a horse with enough stamina, and we know that this one will be able to handle the trip without any issue.
