**BEST BET: Race 7 - #6 Reflected Star**

Making his third start off of a roughly 11 month layoff, this gelding will take a significant drop in class today and looks to meet the right field. The pace looks a little suspect in here, and we'll probably will see speed coming from the rail runner, Darn That Parker, and the #3, Abbot. Given this, I like that Reflected Star has been mid-pack in his last two race, and leading jockey Luis Saez, who takes the mount today, will surely have him placed in a good spot early on. Trainer Bill Mott's barn has been on a roll lately at Gulfstream, too.

**LONGSHOT: Race 2 - #5 Guidonia**

This filly definitely has some dirtied up form, but there are a few things I like about her, besides the price you'll probably get. She clearly hasn't succeeded on the turf, so the connections now opt to run her on dirt. This was actually the scene of her only win, in a race that was taken off the turf but with a track labeled fast. She was off a bit slow, but rallied to close and win by open lengths in a 12 horse field. Not to mention, she gets class relief today and is sent out by a great trainer/jockey combo in Victor Barboza Jr. and Emisael Jaramillo.
