Her latest work over the Gulfstream main track is very encouraging, and this outfit does a great job spotting horses properly off the claim.

**LONGSHOT: Race 10 - #3 Blacksburg**

First time starters do not have the biggest success rate for trainer Barclay Tagg, who is an excellent horseman, and usually tends to take a more patient approach with his maidens. However, this gelding by Ghostzapper has the pedigree to be a good one, and has been working strongly. There are some questions with the main contenders in this race, and perhaps a firmer who is out of a multiple graded stakes winning mare can shake things up.
