BEST BET: Race 13 - #1 Sadler's Joy

This horse has a real affinity for Gulfstream Park, as he won the G2 Pan American here and finished second by a head in the G3 W.L. McKnight last year. He hasn't raced since the Breeders' Cup in early November, but he has shown that he runs well as a fresh horse. Not to mention, he ran a big race in the Breeders' Cup Turf, finishing behind the likes of classy, world-renown horses like Talismanic and Highland Reel. There have been four next-out winners from that race, all of them in graded stakes.

LONGSHOT: Race 7 - #2 My Favorite Gift

While she doesn't have any turf pedigree on the bottom side, this filly is by Tapit and I noted last time that she had a good turf hoof and had the physical for the grass. She showed her signature speed last out in the G3 Sweetest Chant (her first start on the turf) and finished a solid fourth, beaten three lengths by the probable favorite in here, Thewayiam. My Favorite Gift has been working very well since her last start and should be a nice price.
