LONGSHOT: Race 3 - #6 Arch Legacy

The race did not come up particularly fast in terms of Beyer Speed Figures, but this filly faces a field where the main contenders have their own fair share of questions. Trainer Jane Cibelli keeps her at a comparable price tag for her step up to the next level.
