BEST BET: Race 12 - #6 Biblical

The half-brother to the sensational Princess of Sylmar, Biblical is coming off of a bit of a freshening after his graded stakes debut last-out in the G2 Remsen. He broke his maiden two back going 9 furlongs, and has been training really well at Palm Beach Downs. Trainer Todd Pletcher does an excellent job preparing horses like this to return to the races.

LONGSHOT: Race 13 - #3 Missworldvenezuela

This mare definitely has some dirtied up form, but she's getting back to her preferred surface and has natural speed. Looking at her race at this level two starts back, Missworldvenezuela drew a far outside post and had to be hard-used early. Drawing inside today, she should be able to ration that speed better, and also has Emisael Jaramillo in the saddle, who has handled her well in the past.
