She meets a very solid field today, but I think that Yes I'll Go finds herself in the right spot for a big performance. She has a good stalking running style that should serve her well here, as I think she'll sit the perfect trip behind the speed. In addition, she ran into graded stakes winners Curlin's Approval and Rich Mommy last time out in a very tough rendition of the Anna T, and ran a solid fourth that day.

LONGSHOT: Race 1 - #6 Striking Heir

Her last two races have been a bit sub-par, but I think striking heir is going to be the controlling speed here in the opener and has legitimate excuses for those last two races. Two starts back, it was a race going 5 furlongs on the turf, when it seems clear that this horse is much more effective going two turns. Last time out, even though the time was modest, none of the pacesetters were really able to hold on and longshot Beneficiary closed to win at a big price. I think Striking Heir is a good bet under Miguel Vasquez.
