He easily answers questions that others in this field cannot: he can stay the distance, and comes from a barn that does well with last-out winners. Jockey Jose Ortiz will stay aboard.

LONGSHOT: Race 8 - #3 Dizzy Gillespie

Dropping in class after facing significantly tougher in his last two starts, not only does Dizzy Gillespie fit among these foes, but the race flow should be very much in his favor. There is plenty of speed to his inside, and this gelding should sit a perfect trip off the speed, just like he did when he won at this level back in December.
