LONGSHOT: Race 11 - #9 Plein Air

This is a horse who definitely has some dirtied up form in her last couple of starts, and that should ensure she's a nice price today. Last time out, at double digit odds, she was closing strongly late to finish a good third, and I think she'll get plenty of pace to run at this time around. I do hope that she is not place quite as far back in the pack as she was last time, as it seems that this filly was just left with too much to do.
