Get tied on for a 12-race Saturday at Gulfstream Park. First post on a program anchored by the \$100,000 Big Drama Stakes, is about 12:50 ET. Speaking of the Big Drama – boy, how good was Big Drama and his Eclipse Award winning four-year-old campaign in 2010? – I like Garter and Tie as he steps up to face older horses for the first time. I'm also a fan of Gulfstream Park's early season maiden sprints for two-year-olds. Races 4 and 7 fit that bill ever so nicely...

**Bay Society** – This filly debuts for co-leading trainer Saffie Joseph Jr. as a daughter of freshman sire Seek Again. Seek Again was a Juddmonte Farms homebred that won five turf races and about \$900,000. Note that Bay Society originally sold for \$15,000 as a yearling but recently went for \$55,000 at OBS March. She is the third foal from a dam that won one of 10 races – her lone victory came going long on the dirt. Bay Society has an older sister that won four of seven races over the dirt and was a two-year-old winner to boot.

**Carolyn's Smile** – Hard not to be impressed by freshman sire Khozan and his two recent GP maiden winners (he had another horse racing Thursday in race 8.) Carolyn's Smile starts for top trainer Ralph Nicks, has leading rider Edgard Zayas; her dam was winless in three starts; Carolyn's Smile is the third foal in the family – an older brother won twice over the dirt as a two-year-old.

**Sonar** – This Brethren filly is one of two key experienced fillies in the 4<sup>th</sup> race. I really like the way she finished up in her debut (while green) behind a pair of wire-to-wire dead-heat winners.

**Gladita** – My first-out trip note for this Munnings filly: "chased inside, no punch while chasing a wire-to-wire winner, solid gallop out."
