### GP's Winter Meet Wrap-Up

Sunday is last call here at Gulfstream Park. This four-month winter meet concludes with an 11-race card, a regular first-race post time and mandatory payouts in the Rainbow 6, late Pick 5 and Super High 5. Good luck! And, of course, thank you for supporting Gulfstream Park throughout the season – and don't forget that the GP Spring Meeting kicks off this coming Thursday. We race on a Thursday through Sunday schedule through the end of September. As for Sunday's on-track action, I do like the race 9-bound Majestic Maiara quite a bit. Not only does this Majestic Warrior mare return off a recent win at the start of the month, she is starting for a near-40% barn here this winter in trainer Marcial Navarro. I like her to score over the Tammy Levy-trained Cordele, a Lonhro mare who sports the best recent form and sharpest consistency of the 9<sup>th</sup> race crew. This mare has posted an impressive lifetime record of 8-0-5 from 22 starts and has crossed the finish line first in three of her last four races (she was disqualified three starts ago right around New Year's Day.) Veteran jockey Roberto Alvarado Jr. has the call from post 5. Speaking of high-percentage trainers, the Rohan Crichton-trained Pure Style may very well start the Sunday card in the winners' circle. This first-time gelding bombed here last summer in two races at 1/2 and 3/5 odds but faces a very modest crew.
