### Sunday's Turf-Bound Maidens

Plot lines most definitely collide midway through Sunday's 11-race Gulfstream Park program. First-race post time, on this post-Preakness Stakes afternoon, is 1:20 ET. Race 7 is a definite highlight of mine for a few reasons: it has an 11 horse cast, a key April 25<sup>th</sup> grudge match between Ghostly Beauty and Elite Appeal as well as a major west-to-east shipper in Meanasasnake.

**Meanasasnake** – This Florida-bred tried the big gals at Santa Anita Park nearly three months ago. Her debut, a race she was sent off at nearly 53-1 odds, was a mostly forgettable 10<sup>th</sup>-place finish. Definitely note, however, that the winner, Maxim Rate, has since gone on to win the Grade 3 Seniorita at Santa Anita Park. Meanasasnake starts for leading trainer Saffie Joseph Jr. and jockey Miguel Vasquez.

**Ghostly Beauty** – I easily prefer this Noble Mission filly in her rematch with Elite Appeal. Trained by George Weaver, Ghostly Beauty took the worst of it from a tough outside post in her most recent start at GP, her debut against Florida-breds. She was a very good second behind 15-1 winning Cassidy's Smile considering Ghostly Beauty was hung out to dry in "no man's land" while at least three wide around both turns. That said, Ghostly Beauty landed post 11 of 11 here Sunday. Emisael Jaramillo has the mount.
