Championship Meet Statistics (through 12/15):

GP Meet: 120-32-18-23 (\$1.80 /\$5.23) **Best Bet:** 12-4-1-2 (\$1.67/\$4.90) **Longshot:** 8-2-1-1 (\$3.63 /\$9.00)

Race 1: The Buccheros sure do love the Tapeta, so you have to think his daughter 6 Elusive Chalice will take to it on debut, while facing a field full of questions too. And that list includes 7 SPIRITED BOSS, who will be bet hard for D'Angelo and Irad, but goes for a barn that is just 9% with firsters, so she may need this. The experience edge that 8 TIME LEAP has is big, and the MSW drop won't hurt either, so she's in the mix.

SELECTIONS: 6-7-8-5

Race 2: A battle (seemingly) between

3 WARDA and 6 BUBBLY CHAMPAGNE goes
to the former, who drops stiffly and has
sprint speed/form, which gives her a big leg
up on the latter, who has been doing the
two-turn thing of late and will have to
hustle early to keep contact. The gap to the
rest, including 1 DOWN IN THE BAYOU,
seems a big one, though she too drops and
could wake up in her first start for Gonzalez.

SELECTIONS: 3-6-1-8

Race 3: The MSW drop, addition of blinkers, and Barboza hitting at 30% with second-out maidens says they have to beat 6 GRAND JOKER in his Tapeta bow, especially since he caught a very strong field in his debut on the dirt. The local Tapeta agreed with

7 TIME FOR RESTRAINT, as he was a solid 3rd, and it won't take much improvement to get the job done here. They'll overbet **3 ROUNDTRIPTOITALY** on the MSW drop and with Irad, but he was dreadful last time, so tread lightly before come back to him.

SELECTIONS: 6-7-3-9

Race 4: Thinking 2 BREEZEY BELLA is live in her first start in 16 months, as this is Meneses' lone mount on the card, she's worked well for this, and adds Lasix too. Her stablemate 6 CAJUNETTE is the one to beat after a quartet of MSW runs to start her career, plus she has a big recency edge as well. The rail is no great shakes, but 1 FIVE EYES ONMICHEL is another MSW dropper, and she's faced some good ones so far too.

SELECTIONS: 2-6-1-4

Race 5: It's Longshot time, as 6 ARISAEMA returns to the local lawn, where she was a decent 5th against better to-back, and there's enough speed here to set her up late as well. A wide draw (the rails are at 59' too) and other speed, not to mention a short price, says to try and beat 9 HIGHWAY HARMONY, even though her form is best after some NY turf runs against better. The expected hot pace will aid the late run of

10 MISCREANT, and she's another who has been facing better in NY, though her 0-for-5 local mark on the turf is unappealing.

SELECTIONS: 6-9-10-1

Race 6: It's Best Bet time with 2 DOMINANT DIVA, as she looks like another Saffie buzzsaw who is primed for her debut, after some blazing AM activity, while catching a slew of firsters who may need a race. Which brings us to 4 LAULAUGA, a McKinzie filly who likely has talent for Gustavo Delgado, but figures to want longer than the 6Fs she gets on debut today. Cleary a six-month layoff wasn't the plan after 5 FRIDA was 2nd on debut, and that was against state breds too, so she could be vulnerable here.

SELECTIONS: 2-4-5-6

Race 7: Thinking 4 MOTOWN MIKA is live in her local bow for Sweezey, who has come out firing, and note she's run well here on the Tapeta in the past. The class rise could trip up 7 LITA, but that was a sharp win last time, and Irad sticks as well. Fading 3 HITS DIFFERENT, who has no speed and is 0-for-10 on the GP Tapeta, yet will be bet on the drop for Saffie and Zayas.

SELECTIONS: 4-7-3-8

Race 8: The post says 6 FULANITO can get the better of 3 ASHER'S EDGE in a compact feature, as he's outside his main rival and may get first run too, at what should be a better price as well. Tabbing Woodbine invader 4 ADIOS NOW for next time, as those from the north typically need one locally before firing their best shot.

SELECTIONS: 6-3-4-1

Race 9: Stabbing wildly in the finale with 6 JUDGE JUDITH, who stretches back out and has speed, which many of the perceived favorites don't have. No doubt that 4 STRAND OF GOLD is the one to beat for top connections, and the drop is a big one too, but she also seems a bit too good to trust, at very short odds too. A lack of early foot won't help 5 SALS DREAM GIRL, though she'll run on late, as always.

SELECTIONS: 6-4-5-7

Best Bet: R6: #2 Dominant Diva (9-5)

- * Another Saffie with hot AM works
- * Other firsters figure to want longer
- * Gets 7-pound break with Husbands

Longshot: R5: #6 Arisaema (12-1)

- * Drops after facing better two-back
- * Plenty of speed sets up her late run
- * Both (ML) favorites have some warts
