



# RACE BY RACE ANALYSIS

## RACE 1:

**4 FULMINATE** is a daughter of Get Stormy debuting vs the boys - for trainer Mark Casse - who is 5 for 7 (74%) with his 2-year-old first-time starters. Note that Edwin Gonzalez is also 5 for 7 riding 2-year-olds at the meeting.

**3 C MY MEISTER** is stretching out around 2-turns on the turf after tracking the pace and finishing a useful 4<sup>th</sup> in his 4 ½-furlong debut on the main track. The son of Bodemeister is bred on both sides of the family tree to respond favorably to both the surface and distance.

**6 PHARAOH'S PROPHECY** is a son of Pioneerofthe Nile debuting for trainer Mike Maker with the breeding need to handle both the surface at the 7 ½ furlong distance. The barn, 18% with their turf runners, has Emisael Jaramillo in the saddle.

**SELECTIONS: 4-3-6**

## RACE 2:

**7 TIZ POSSIBLE DEAR** moves to the Victor Barboza Jr barn via the claim after turning on the afterburners to defeat \$12,500 state-bred optional claimers at the distance by 7 ½ lengths. The barn, 33% with new claims, keeps the status quo with Edgard Zayas in the saddle. **4 BIMINI** is stretching out to her best distance (9-4-2-0) after her 2-race win streak ended when she finished a stalk-and-fade 3<sup>rd</sup> vs this level of competition going 7 furlongs last out. **5 HARTLING** is another stretching out her most accomplished distance (6-4-1-0) after losing her best chance when she broke slowly from the rail when 4<sup>th</sup> behind Bimini going 7 panels last out.

**SELECTIONS: 7-4-5**

## RACE 3:

**5 NOBLE DREAMER** should be primed and ready to score after vying for the lead and finishing 2<sup>nd</sup> in her career debut at this level and distance. Leading trainer Saffie Joseph Jr has Edgard Zayas returning on the daughter of Noble Bird.

**3 LULI'S DANCER** will be outfitted with blinkers after setting a pressured pace and weakening to finish 3<sup>rd</sup> behind Noble Dreamer last out. The recent half-mile bullet workout in 47 & 2 indicates the blinkers can help her reverse the previous outcome. **7 DELIGHTFUL BREEZE** is a daughter of win-early sire Cajun Breeze debuting for Kathleen O'Connell, who has a solid 19%-win average with her freshman runners.

**SELECTIONS: 5-3-7**

## RACE 4:

**5 MORNING COLORS**, now in the Lisa Lewis barn, the daughter of Midshipman has been training forwardly in preparation for the first start since coming within a neck of winning at this level here during December: Luca Panici rides.

**1 DADDY'S JOY** will try \$25,000 conditioned claimers after showing speed and getting caught late - as the favorite - in a pair of \$20,000 state-bred allowance optional claimers before going to the bench in April. Saffie Joseph Jr, 23% with the 61-180 days layoff, has Edgard Zayas handling this inside speed play. **6 ROSA STAR** is cutting back slightly to 7 ½ furlongs after chasing the pace and finishing 3<sup>rd</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>, respectively, in a pair vs similar going a mile. Javier Negrete has Edwin Gonzalez atop the speed of the speed.

**SELECTIONS: 5-1-6**

## RACE 5:

**9 FOREVER SOUPER** is a son of American Pharoah debuting for trainer Mark Casse with a string of solid workouts showing in preparation for the debut. The barn, 5 for 7 with their freshman runners, has red-hot jock Edwin Gonzalez in the irons.

**5 OCTANE** is a gelded son of Brethren debuting for Arindel, and trainer Carlos David, with Emisael Jaramillo named handle the half-brother to local stakes performer Gatsby.

**6 LIGHTENING LARRY** is stretching out to five-eighths of a mile after chasing the pace and finishing 2<sup>nd</sup> in his 4 ½-furlong debut. Jeff Engler has Romero Maragh atop the only previous starter in the field.

**SELECTIONS: 9-5-6**

**RACE 6:**

**2 RESTOFTHESTORY**, who was 2<sup>nd</sup> – beaten a neck – in the mile and a sixteenth \$400,000 My Dear Girl as a 2-year-old, stretches out to a mile after rallying between horses to finish 3<sup>rd</sup> vs state-bred allowance runners going 7 furlongs. Trainer Ed Plesa Jr has Edgard Zayas atop the daughter of Jess’s Dream. **1 PACIFIC PRINCESS**, bred to handle the distance, the daughter of Prospective stretches out after returning from Tampa to defeat \$25,000 starter optional claimers here going 6 furlongs. Trainer Roger Laurin has Chantal Sutherland handling the added distance.

**6 NO DECAF** is another trying a mile today after returning from the layoff to set a pressured pace before fading to 5<sup>th</sup> behind the top choice going seven-eighths of a mile. She’ll be in the first flight playing catch me if you can.

**SELECTIONS: 2-1-6**

**RACE 7:**

**7 EXTRAVAGANT ROSIE** is dropping into this conditioned claimer after returning from Tampa to press the pace and finish a tiring 5<sup>th</sup> behind a hard-knocking field of \$25,000 allowance optional claimers. Trainer Dennis Ward has Edgard Zayas atop the daughter of Treasure Beach.

**1 GYPSY WIFE** is stepping up to the \$20,000 level after responding in the first race after the claim by Peter Walder with a well-meant 2<sup>nd</sup> – as the favorite - vs \$12,500 claimers going this mile distance: Miguel Vazquez rides. **2 GLOVANNA** was solid in defeat when returning from Tampa to rally between horses to finish 2<sup>nd</sup> – at 63-1 – at this level and distance. She’s certainly worth a flyer at a price.

**SELECTIONS: 7-1-2**

**RACE 8:**

**8 FRONT LOADED** will try to make it 2 in a row after responding in the first race after the claim by Georgina Baxter by defeating a field of \$35,000 conditioned claimers by almost 8 lengths: Edwin Gonzalez rides. **2 KALU** is wheeling back after a tough loss at this level and distance in which he set a pressured pace and was beaten a neck. Trainer Kent Sweezey has Emisael Jaramillo in the irons. **9 WHISKEY SUNRISE** is hoping to make amends after finishing 2<sup>nd</sup> behind Front Loaded as the odd-on choice last out. Trainer Mike Yates has Jesus Rios handling the gelded son of Cajun Breeze.

**SELECTIONS: 8-2-9**

**RACE 9:**

**8 BIG FRANK**, popular in the claiming box, the gelding moves to the Mike Maker barn, and goes to the turf, after a pair of well-meant 2<sup>nd</sup> place finishes on the dirt, including the maiden score 2 starts back, and the well-meant 3<sup>rd</sup> vs this level of competition going a mile last out.

**7 EXPRESS PHAROAH** is back locally after following a respectable 4<sup>th</sup> place finish here at this level and distance with a 2<sup>nd</sup> -place finish at \$50 cents to the dollar- vs \$25,000 ‘2-lifetime’ claimers at Tampa. Victor Barboza Jr has Emisael Jaramillo named to ride. **9 MR. AXEL** is stretching out slightly after surrendering a late lead to finish 2<sup>nd</sup> – as the favorite – going 7 ½ furlongs on a softened turf lasted as good: Edwin Gonzalez rides.

**SELECTIONS: 8-7-9**

**BEST BET: RACE 6 – 2 RESTOFTHESTORY**

**LONGSHOT: RACE 9 – 8 BIG FRANK**
