



# RACE BY RACE ANALYSIS

## RACE 1:

**3 PRINCESS SADIE** is dropping to the \$12,500 level after facing tougher on both turf and dirt in California while in the Doug O'Neill barn. The Cal-bred daughter of Congrats gets treated with Lasix by new trainer Joe Orseno.

**4 UNDERCOVER OUTLAW**, who has some solid turf sprint performances vs tougher on the go-back, returns to the grass after finishing 4<sup>th</sup> vs \$16,000 maidens going 5 furlongs in a rained-out sprint on the Tampa main track during June. Samy Camacho rides for Nancy Harris. **11 TRIPLET**, stuck on the top of the also eligible list, the Anthony's Cross filly jumps off the page if she can get into the field. **8 MISS YAYA** is debuting on the turf after hitting the board in 2 of 5 races vs similar quality on the dirt. Jose Morelos rides

**SELECTIONS: 3-4-11-8**

## RACE 2:

**7 FINANCIAL SYSTEM** is going back to the main track after his 2-race win streak vs this level of competition on the dirt ended when he took a sightseeing trip vs \$25,000 optional claimers going a mile on the turf. Jorge Delgado is 20% with the grass to dirt angle.

**6 MAN OF VISION** moves to the Juan Avila barn via the claim, and steps up the competition, after drawing clear to defeat \$6,250 open claimers going 6 furlongs. Angel Arroyo handles the stretchout to seven-eighths of a mile.

**3 UNCAPTURED KING** is wheeling back after stalking the pace and finishing 4<sup>th</sup> behind a pair of next-out winners in a fruitful sprint at this level and distance. Note the jock/trainer combo of Prado and Collazo is 3 for 6 (50%) locally.

**SELECTIONS: 7-6-3**

## RACE 3:

**4 FIERY PRINCESS** is stepping up to the \$10,000 level after posting her 3<sup>rd</sup> consecutive victory when cruising through her maiden, 2 and 3 'lifetime' conditions in impressive fashion. Renaldo Richards has J J Gonzales going for the 4-peat. **5 KHOZY DREAMS** is stepping up off the claim by Rodolfo Garcia after drawing clear to defeat \$6,250 claimers with a sharp 3-wide move. Miguel Vazquez rides.

**2 HI DOLLFACE** is making her first start since drawing away to defeat \$12,500 conditioned claimers in a \$12,500 sprint moved from turf to 5 furlongs on the dirt. Mike Lerman has Chantal Sutherland handling the return to action.

**SELECTIONS: 4-5-2**

## RACE 4:

**3 WITCH HUNTER** is turning back to one of her best distances (5-2-1-1) after following a score at this 7-furlong distance 2 starts back with a slow starting 2<sup>nd</sup> vs \$16,000 starter optional claimers going a mile last out. Victor Barboza Jr is solid with the route to sprint move.

**4 SKY CHASER**, another from the Victor Barboza juggernaut, drops into this \$20,000 starter allowance in the first start since he claimed him out of a \$62,500 optional claimer going 7 furlongs during May. The barn, 31% with new claims, has Edgard Zayas at the controls.

**5 NATIONALIST** moves to the Rohan Crichton barn via the claim after drawing clear to defeat \$6,250 open claimers going a mile. Crichton, 21% with new claims, keeps Chantal atop the 4-year-old daughter of Prospective.

**SELECTIONS: 3-4-5**



**RACE 5:**

**1 OCEAN SAFARI** is hoping for a clean trip after having to steady going into the turn, then was bothered in the stretch, and still managing to get beat on a neck when 3<sup>rd</sup> in her career debut at this level and distance. Gilberto Zerpa has Cristian Torres returning on the daughter of Temple City. **8 PALMACH** is a daughter of Violence debuting for Mark Casse with a consistent work tab showing on both turf and dirt at Palm Meadows. Note the jock/trainer combo of E Gonzalez and Casse is 9 for 18 (50%) at the meeting. **3 MAGNOLIA ROAD** departs from an improved post after breaking from the outside (Post 10), and bumping at the start, prior to finishing a rally 4<sup>th</sup> going this 7 ½-furlong distance on turf. Sano has Edgard at the controls.

**SELECTIONS: 1-8-3**

**RACE 6:**

**5 SPROUT WINGS** will try to make it 3 in a row after returning from the layoff to defeat \$25,000 optional claimers going 6 ½ furlongs. Trainer Teri Pompay has Miguel Vazquez returning on the lightly raced daughter of Upstart.

**4 R PREROGATIVE** has been knocking on the door when 2<sup>nd</sup> in both recent sprints vs this caliber of competition, and just needs a like push from Lady Luck to get her picture taken.

**2 CRUMB BUN** is cutting back to 6 furlongs after dueling for the lead and finishing 2<sup>nd</sup> – beaten three-parts of a length – vs \$62,500 optional claimers going a mile. The mare is definitely spotted for success.

**SELECTIONS: 5-4-2**

**RACE 7:**

**8 SHARM EL SHEIKH** is cutting back to a mile after leading every step of the way to defeat this level of competition going a mile and a sixteenth. Trainer Murat Sancal has Luca Panici going for 2 in a row. **6 POSITIVE PHIL** moves to Alfredo Cazares barn via the claim hoping the change in scenery will help recapture the form he displayed winning consecutive turf races during May and June. Jonathan Gonzales rides.

**4 ROCKET JOE COPPER**, a 6-time turf winner, is going back to the grass after drawing clear to defeat \$12,500 dated claimers going a mile on a sealed sloppy track. Kathleen O’Connell has Samy Camacho going for 2 in a row.

**SELECTIONS: 8-6-4**

**RACE 8:**

**7 JOSHY JAK** is stretching out to a mile after rallying in his 2<sup>nd</sup> start back from the layoff with an improved 2<sup>nd</sup> place finish going 6 furlongs. The 3<sup>rd</sup> start off the bench should bring positive results. **4 KHOZY MY BOY** is going back to the main track after following another ‘in the money’ finish on the dirt (23-1-9-2) with a duel and weaken 6<sup>th</sup> – beaten 2 lengths – vs \$16,000 state-bred optional claimers going 7 ½ furlongs on the turf: Emisael Jaramillo rides for Juan C Avila. **5 DIMENNA** is stepping up, and stretching out, after returning from the layoff to defeat \$35,000 maidens by 5 ½ lengths when going 6 furlongs last out. Ralph Nicks has Samy Camacho up.

**SELECTIONS: 7-4-5**

**RACE 9:**

**3 SISTER IS DEVIL** is making the usually 3<sup>rd</sup> start back from the layoff, and cutting back to a mile, after disputing the pace and tiring when facing this level of competition going a mile and a sixteenth. Liz Dobles has Leonel Reyes handling this upset pace play. **5 BRODY’S HONOR** is the logical choice in the nightcap when he cuts back to the mile after rolling past Sister Is Devil to score going 8 ½ furlongs last out. Jose D’Angelo has Emisael Jaramillo going for 2 in a row. **8 KARENVILLE** is stretching out an additional half-furlong after the solid \$16,000 maiden score, from a demanding outside post, going 7 ½ furlongs. Edgard Zayas rides.

**SELECTIONS: 2-5-8**

**BEST BET: RACE 5 – 1 OCEAN SAFARI**

**LONGSHOT: RACE 9 – 2 SISTER IS DEVIL**
