



# RACE BY RACE ANALYSIS

## RACE 1:

**11 RENEESDREAMGIRL**, beaten a neck at this level in her debut, drops, and wears blinkers, after coming up empty vs \$25,000 maidens in her last. Antonio Sano, 28% with first-time blinkers, has the daughter of Young Brian working sharply for this assignment. **7 KINGSTON QUEEN** is dropping to this level on the dirt again after following the 4<sup>th</sup> behind Reneesdreamgirl in their respective debuts with a 3<sup>rd</sup> place finish vs \$40,000 maidens going 5 panels on the turf. **12 PURE AMBITION** breaks from the outside after departing from the rail and finishing 2<sup>nd</sup> in her debut at this level and distance. Rodolfo Garcia has Miguel Vazquez handling the outside draw.

**SELECTIONS: 11-7-12**

## RACE 2:

**9 UNMARKED MONEY** will try a mile after getting beat a neck going 7 ½ furlongs 2 starts back, and 3<sup>rd</sup> – as the favorite – going 8 ½ furlongs last out. Victor Barboza Jr has Miguel Vazquez up.

**10 EMPEROR'S SONG** is stretching out around 2-turns after rallying to finish 2<sup>nd</sup> in back-to-back 5-furlong turf sprints. Trainer Jose Gallegos has apprentice Mario Fuentes handling the stretchout.

**1 BELLE'S KINGDOM** is dropping back to a level where she finished 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>, respectively, to merit some attention on the ticket for Joe Orseno and jockey Luca Panici.

**SELECTIONS: 9-10-1**

## RACE 3:

**5 TONALISM** is dropping back to the level where he reeled off consecutive victories after rallying 4-wide to finish 3<sup>rd</sup> in a \$60,000 overnight handicap going 6 furlongs. He jumps off the page vs this level of opposition. **7 OLD TIME REVIVAL** is cutting back to 7 furlongs after returning from the layoff to finish a set-the-pace-and-weaken 4<sup>th</sup> vs \$25,000 optional claimers going a mile. Ralph Nicks has Samy Camacho returning on the 3-time winner at this tricky distance.

**1 UNCORK THE BOTTLE** is stretching out to seven-eighths after returning from the layoff to make a middle move and weaken vs \$25,000 optional claimers going 6 ½ furlongs. Gilberto Zerpa is 20% with the 2<sup>nd</sup> start off the bench.

**SELECTIONS: 5-7-1**

## RACE 4:

**1 DRINKSONTHEBEACH** will depart from the rail after breaking from the outside (Post 10), dueling for the lead, and tiring to finish 6<sup>th</sup> in his 7 ½ furlong turf debut. Trainer Laura Cazares has Miguel Vazquez handling the rail post. **4 PHARAOH'S PROPHECY** is hoping for clear sailing after encountering early trouble (bumped twice) prior to setting the pace and finishing 5<sup>th</sup> in his turf debut for trainer Mike Maker: Chantal Sutherland rides. **2 CLASSIC FILM** is dropping to the \$35,000 level after showing some early interest and fading in back-to-back grass outings vs maiden special weight competition. Kent Sweezey has Angel Arroyo handling the class relief.

**SELECTIONS: 1-4-2**

## RACE 5:

**7 KIGER** is freefalling to the \$6,250 level after hitting the board in 1 of 2 recent outings going a mile vs \$35,000 claimers. Leading trainer Saffie Joseph Jr has Edwin Gonzalez handling the dropdown.

**8 HARD TEN**, a solid maiden winner on the dirt vs this level of competition 2 starts back, is going back to the main track after getting mugged early and never getting untracked vs \$12,500 claimers going 8 ½ furlongs on the turf. Jorge Delgado, 21% with the turf-to-dirt angle, has go-to jock Chantal Sutherland in the irons. **3 SAMARONTI** is wheeling back after taking the overland route when finishing a wide 2<sup>nd</sup> at this level and distance last out. Gustavo Delgado has Cristian Torres penciled in for the return riding assignment.

**SELECTIONS: 7-8-3**



**RACE 6:**

**2 PIPER** is hoping to save a tad more for the stretch drive after setting the pace and just getting nipped at the wire when 2<sup>nd</sup> at this level and distance. Trainer Carlos David has Emisael Jaramillo atop the 3-year-old daughter of Brethren.

**5 BAHAMIAN RHAPSODY** is hoping to get away from the starting gate trouble free after following a pair of turf sprints where she was part of the pace with a come-from-behind 4<sup>th</sup> last time out. Gilberto Zerpa tabs Samy Camacho to ride as Jaramillo sticks with the top choice. **1 ROYAL HABIBI** is going back to the turf after following a narrow defeat at this level on the grass with a troubled starting last (shut off) going 6 ½ furlongs in the slop during June. Jorge Delgado adds blinkers, and has Chantal in the saddle.

**SELECTIONS: 2-5-1**

**RACE 7:**

**5 BULLET ON TAP** is cutting back to three-quarters of a mile after dueling for the lead, racing greenly through the stretch, and still managing to finish 2<sup>nd</sup> in her 7-furlong debut. Kelsey Danner, 22% with her 2-year-old runners, has Miguel Vazquez atop the daughter of Tapiture. **8 MUTED**, a \$450,000 daughter of Into Mischieff, debuts for trainer Tom Proctor with a string of solid workouts showing over the Palm Meadows training track. Emisael Jaramillo rides the regally bred freshman.

**3 FULL OF ATTITUDE** is a daughter of win-early sire Khozan debuting for Mark Casse, who leads all trainers with 8 freshman winners from 37 starters (22%). The tote action will tell us more.

**SELECTIONS: 5-8-3**

**RACE 8:**

**5 TRIPLE JEOPARDY**, 3 for 4 in the money on the turf, returns to the grass after responding in the first race after the claim by the red-hot Carlos David barn with a neck defeat vs \$35,000 conditioned claimers going a mile on the dirt: Samy Camacho rides.

**2 PLENUM** is stretching out to a mile again after finishing 2<sup>nd</sup> again when rallying to come within a neck of scoring vs this level of competition going 7 ½ furlongs. Oscar Gonzalez has Jaramillo atop the logical morning line favorite.

**9 TIMMY M.** is stretching out after rallying from far back to finish 4<sup>th</sup> – a head and a neck – behind Plenum last out. Joe Orseno has Edwin Gonzalez handling the rematch.

**SELECTIONS: 5-2-9**

**RACE 9:**

**2 TROPHY CHASER**, who has world class closing speed, returns from the extended layoff looking to sit in the catbird seat behind the hot pace expected. The multiple graded stakes placed 5-year-old may have tipped his hand with sizzling half-mile drill in :46 & 3. **8 ROUGH ENTRY** has been nothing less than sensational when reeling off 4 consecutive victories. He'll be tested for class if Trophy Chaser bring his A game. **4 WILLY BOI** is going back to the main track, and getting Lasix, after failing to fire when shipped to Del Mar to compete at 5 furlongs on the turf. The winner of 3 of 6 locally, including the Hutcheson Stakes, will be a major part of pace setup.

**SELECTIONS: 2-8-4**

**RACE 10:**

**7 SMOOTH MUSIC** is dropping to the \$12,500 level again after running a vastly improved 2<sup>nd</sup> in front of next-out winner Khocu – when sent off at 23-1 - in a \$16,000 maiden turf sprint. Trainer Kent Sweezey has Angel Arroyo in the irons. **4 VICMAR** should have the screws tightened after returning from the 8-month layoff to finish a troubled starting 4<sup>th</sup> (bumped) at this level and distance. Efren Loza Jr has Jesus Rios handling the 2<sup>nd</sup> start off the bench.

**9 INVISIBLE ENEMY** is a son of Lookin At Lucky debuting for trainer Carlos David, and that should be more than enough to pique your interest. Tab the tote action for more clues about the colt's readiness to win at first asking.

**SELECTIONS: 7-4-9**

**BEST BET: RACE 9 – 2 TROPHY CHASER**

**LONGSHOT: RACE 7 – 5 BULLET ON TAP**
