



RACE BY RACE ANALYSIS

RACE 1:

7 HONEYMOON SUITE is moving to the main track after dueling for the lead and finishing 3rd in his 5-furlong career debut on the dirt. Trainer Mark Casse has Emisael Jaramillo handling the surface switch.

5 RIDE ON BYE is a son of Tiznow debuting for trainer Jeff Engler with a couple of solid 3-furlong workouts showing in preparation for this assignment: Samy Camacho rides. **1 AKINGISALWAYS KING** is looking to be crowned a winner in his debut for trainer Antonio Sano. The son of American Freedom (Pulpit) shows a series of stamina tweaking Palm Meadows workouts in preparation for his first start: Edgard Zayas rides.

SELECTIONS: 7-5-1

RACE 2:

2 BRAY is dropping a notch after returning from the 3-month layoff to finish a late-charging 2nd – beaten a head - vs \$16,000 dated claimers going a mile. Mike Maker has Emisael Jaramillo atop the 3-time winner at the distance. **7 TIL THE END** drops into this dated claimer, and stretches out to a mile and a sixteenth, after rallying to finish 2nd vs \$16,000 state-bred optional claimers going a mile. The only concern is the zero-for-9 record at the distance (9-0-2-3).

10 HARBOUR MASTER (GB) is trying 'non-winners of a race since December 26' after prompting the pace and finishing 2nd vs \$12,500 open claimers going 8 furlongs. Patrick Biancone tabs Romero Maragh to ride.

SELECTIONS: 2-7-10

RACE 3:

7 CAJUN MANDATE is dropping to the \$25,000 level after bobbling at the start and finishing last in his maiden special weight debut going 4 ½ furlongs. Trainer Mike Yates is 23% with maidens making their 2nd start. **3 SCHENECTADY STAR** is a gelded son of Cairo Prince debuting for trainer Tim Hamm with a couple of stamina tweaking 5-furlong workouts showing in preparation for the debut: Romero Maragh rides. **4 SKIPPERINI** is a gelded son of Black Stash (Bernardini) debuting for Pete Wasiluk Jr with jockey Edwin Gonzalez up. Note that Gonzalez has crossed the wire first with 5 of his 9 (56%) 2-year-old mounts.

SELECTIONS: 7-3-4

RACE 4: *THE NOT SURPRISING*

6 KING OF DREAMS is turning back to a mile after couple of sharp efforts going longer, which includes the set-the-pace 2nd in the 8 ½-furlong English Channel 2 starts back, and the front running \$75,000 allowance score going 9 furlongs last out. **7 FULMINI** will try to make it 2 in a row after recovering from the awkward start to get up at the wire to defeat **4 SIGILOSIO** by a nose last out. The latter shows a sizzling 5-furlong bullet workout in 58 & 3 when he tries to turn the tables on Fulmini, and reel in speedy King of Dreams.

SELECTIONS: 6-7-4

RACE 5:

6 RACE DAY SPEED moves to the Jorge Delgado barn via the claim, cuts back to 6 furlongs, and gets Lasix, after holding on to notch her 3rd career victory going 7 furlongs last out. The barn, 39% with a limited sampling of new claims, has Chantal Sutherland named to ride. **4 DEM A WONDER** is dropping to the \$6,250 level after failing to fire when finishing a fading 5th vs \$20,000 claimers last out. Trainer Kent Sweezey has Edwin Gonzalez handling the class relief.

5 GASPARILLA BLAST drops, and cuts back to a sprint on the dirt, after the chase-and-fade outing vs \$10,000 claimers going a mile on the turf. Trainer Dave Fawkes has Hector Berrios handling the surface change.

SELECTIONS: 6-4-5

RACE 6:

2 FOSTER HOPE is dropping to the \$6,250 level after responding in the first race after the claim by Jose D'Angelo, and the 4-month layoff, with a 3rd-place finish vs \$12,500 '2-lifetime' claimers going three-quarters of a mile. Samy Camacho handles the turnback to 5 ½ furlongs. **6 NO COMMISSION** moves to the Jorge Delgado barn after the claim, and drops to this level, after finishing a troubled starting 6th vs \$12,500 claimers last out. The barn, a monster 33% with new claims, has leading jockey Edgard Zayas in the saddle.

8 LITTLE DUDE is turning back to 5 ½ furlongs after following his \$12,500 maiden score with a 3rd place finish vs this this level of competition going three-quarters of a mile.

SELECTIONS: 2-6-8

RACE 7:

1 PERSONAL MEADOW is cutting back to 5 ½ furlongs after setting the pace and yielding late to finish 2nd vs this level of competition going 6 and 7 furlongs, respectively. Oscar Gonzalez has Emisael Jaramillo handling the mini turnback. **3 THE KING AQUILES** is dropping a notch after re-rallying to finish 3rd when facing \$16,000 maidens going this 5 ½-furlong distance. Luis Ramirez has Chantal Sutherland named to ride. **10 DREAM OF WARRIOR** drops, and turns back, after tracking the pace and finishing 4th vs \$20,000 maidens going three-quarters of a mile. Trainer Juan C Avila has apprentice Franklin Calles handling the outside draw.

SELECTIONS: 1-3-10

RACE 8:

3 KARTANO is back in the allowance optional claiming ranks after finishing a willing 3rd behind speedy 4th race participant King of Dreams in the \$75,000 English Channel. Trainer Efren Loza Jr has Edgard Zayas named to ride. **7 TELLINGTON** is stretching out to a mile and a sixteenth after responding in the first race after the claim by leading trainer Saffie Joseph Jr with a 2nd place finish vs this caliber of competition going a mile: Emisael Jaramillo rides. **10 TODAYSTHEDAY** hopes to live up to his name when he stretches out around 2-turns after returning from the layoff to finish a rallying 2nd vs this level of competition going 5 furlongs. Trainer Kelsey Danner has a positive return of investment (\$2.39) with horses stretching out in distance.

SELECTIONS: 3-7-10

RACE 9:

1 SANDY DUDE is turning back to 7 furlongs after rallying to finish 2nd when facing similar quality in a \$12,500 maiden race contested at a mile. Trainer Barry Croft has Miguel Vazquez handling the inside draw. **3 KATHERN'S JOY** is stepping up to the \$16,000 level again after responding to the addition of Lasix with a 2nd place finish – beaten a neck – vs \$12,500 maidens going seven-eighths of a mile. **7 STATEN ISLAND** was solid in defeat when he dropped from special weight company on the turf, and rallied 4-wide – from a tough post (10) - to finish 3rd vs \$12,500 maidens going this distance. Jeff Engler has Victor Lebron in the saddle.

SELECTIONS: 1-3-7

RACE 10:

7 KRAMDEN is turning back to a mile after responding to the dropdown to this level with a 2nd place finish going a mile and a sixteenth. Trainer Mark Casse has Emisael Jaramillo handling the mile. **1 MR. TITO'S** is stepping up to the next level, and moving to the rail, after breaking from Post 10 and rallying to defeat \$12,500 'non-winners of 2-lifetime' competition going a mile on a softened turf listed as good. Trainer Jennifer Young has Leonel Reyes going for 2 in a row.

9 CALABASH is cutting back to his best distance thus far (4-2-0-0) after tracking the pace and finishing 4th behind Kramden going 8 ½ furlongs. Saffie Joseph Jr has J.C. Diaz Jr riding.

SELECTIONS: 7-1-9

RACE 11:

8 UNION GAP moves to the Bill Tharrenos barn via the claim, and stretches out to a mile, after posting his 3rd consecutive victory when defeating \$6,250 conditioned claimers going 6 furlongs. Jose Morales guides the 3-year-old son of Union Rags. **4 BRACCIO DI FERRO** is dropping to the \$12,500 level after rallying to finish a distant 3rd vs \$20,000 conditioned claimers going a mile. Jose D'Angelo has Edwin Gonzalez trying to notch the gelding's 2nd career victory.

3 BRETT'S WORLD is hoping to bounce back vs this caliber of competition after following his \$20,000 maiden score with duel-and-fade outing behind Braccio Di Ferro last out. Bobby Dibona has Emisael Jaramillo atop the logical pacesetter.

SELECTIONS: 8-4-3

RACE 12:

2 WOLFHAND, beautifully bred for the turf, the gelded son of Candy Ride drops to the \$12,500 level in the first start since showing speed and fading vs maiden special weight company going a mile and sixteenth on the Keeneland main track last July. Murat Sancal removes the blinkers on this intriguing longshot.

6 KICK IN THE GAS is the one to fear in the nightcap when he moves to the Saffie Joseph Jr barn, and drops to this level, after finishing 4th vs \$35,000 maidens here while in the Christophe Clement barn. Blinkers and Edgard Zayas are added for this assignment.

3 LORD DARNLEY is stretching out after rallying to finish 3rd and 2nd, respectively, vs similar going a mile. Roger Laurin has Chantal in the saddle.

SELECTIONS: 2-6-3

BEST BET: RACE 10 – 7 KRAMDEN

LONGSHOT: RACE 12 – 2 WOLFHAND
