



RACE BY RACE ANALYSIS

RACE 1:

9 VICMAR is dropping to the \$12,500 level after showing promise when sprinting vs better before going to the sidelines in December. Efrén Loza Jr is 1 for 2 (50%) with the 180 days-plus layoff.

12 BELLA FUTURE will depart from the outside, and drop a level, after finishing 2nd or 3rd in 5 consecutive turf sprints at the \$16,000 level. Amando De La Cerda has Samy Camacho named to ride.

1 WEATHERFORD is another dropping a notch after returning from the extended layoff to set the pace and fade to finish 6th behind Bella Future. Kelsey Danner is 18% with the 2nd start back from similar layoffs.

SELECTIONS: 9-12-1

RACE 2:

2 J'S INDIAN CHARM, an 11-time winner, steps up, and stretches out, after responding to both the first start off the claim by Georgina Baxter, and the return from the 10-month layoff, with a set-the-pace-and-weaken 3rd vs \$12,500 open claimers going 5 furlongs.

5 K'S RUNNING FREE moves to the Dan Pita barn via the claim after pressing the pace and finishing 3rd behind repeat winner Pretty Rachel in a \$12,500 claimer contested at 6 furlongs on a good track.

3 TAYLOR'S IN ORBIT, a 6-time winner, and another from Georgina Baxter, takes advantage dated claiming conditions of the race after finishing 3rd vs \$12,500 open claimers going 5 furlongs on the turf. The barn, is 24% with the turf to dirt angle.

SELECTIONS: 2-5-3

RACE 3:

4 ON THIN ICE is a son of More Than Ready, out off the Dynaformer mare Frozen Treat, debuting for trainer Mark Casse with strong turf breeding on both sides of the family tree. **5 ELDON'S PRINCE** is a \$280,000 son of Cairo Prince debuting for leading trainer Saffie Joseph Jr with leading jock Edgard Zayas at the controls. The tote action will tell us more. **2 T VILLE** is a son Vancouver, and a half-brother to 2-year-old turf stakes winner Lenzi's Lucky Lady, debuting for Leon McKanas, who is 1 for 2 (50%) with his debut turf runners: Chantal Sutherland rides.

SELECTIONS: 4-5-2

RACE 4:

5 DIMENNA is dropping to the \$35,000 level, and debuting on the main track, after showing speed vs \$50,000 maidens going long on the turf before going to the bench in April. Ralph Nicks, 21% with both the turf to dirt angle, and the 61-180 days layoff, has the son of Flintshire working sharply on the GP main track.

7 PIYPA DE LYNDA is dropping into the maiden claiming ranks after the pair of respectable sprints vs special weight competition. Trainer Angel Penna Jr has Edgar Prado handling the class relief.

4 PROUD CONTENDER is stretching out to 6 ½ furlongs after rallying to finish 3rd vs this level of competition going three-quarters of a mile. Fernando Abreu has Leonel Reyes in the saddle.

SELECTIONS: 5-7-4

RACE 5:

3 KARTANO is going back to his preferred surface after following the well-meant 3rd place finish on the grass in the \$75,000 English Channel with a 2nd place finish going a mile in race moved to the main track.

7 BRIGHT DEVIL is wheeling back after encountering trouble at the start (bobbled, bumped), going up to set a pressured pace on a yielding course, and then tiring from his earlier efforts to finish 3rd in the \$75,000 Not Surprising. Mark Casse has Miguel Vazquez named to ride. **2 FULMINI**, a multiple stakes-placed runner on the turf, who does his best running on a firm course, is poised to rebound after finishing 4th on a yielding surface in the Not Surprising. Carlos David has Samy Camacho up.

SELECTIONS: 3-7-2

RACE 6:

3 STARSHIP TAXI is stretching out to three-quarters of a mile after returning from the layoff to finish 2nd vs this level of competition going 5 ½ furlongs. Diane Morici has Leonel Reyes atop the 6-year-old gelding.

1 UNCAPTURED KING is turning back to a sprint distance after returning from the layoff, breaking from a demanding outside post, and rallying to finish 2nd going a mile. The gelding will have Edgar Prado handling the turnback. **5 FIRST NAVY ADMIRAL** is making his first start since using his speed to defeat \$6,250 '2-lifetime' claimers going 5 ½ furlongs here during May. Ralph Nicks has Samy Camacho going for 2 in a row.

SELECTIONS: 3-1-5

RACE 7:

8 BEAUTY QUEEN is going back to the turf after following her '2-lifetime' victory sprinting on the grass with a 5-wide 3rd in a race moved to 5 furlongs on a fast main track. Carlos David has Angel Arroyo handling the surface switch. **9 BAHAMIAN MOON** will try to make it 2 in a row after stalking early, and edging away, to defeat \$12,500 conditioned claimers in her first ever 5-furlong turf sprint. Dennis Ward has Luca Panici named to ride, as Angel Arroyo sticks with Beauty Queen. **10 LA CARA BONITA** will depart from the outside, and shorten up to her most accomplished distance (12-2-4-4), after disputing the pace and weakening in a pair of 1-mile turf outings at the \$20,000 level. Chantal Sutherland handles the drop to the \$12,500 level.

SELECTIONS: 8-9-10

RACE 8:

1 BEMBE is stretching out to three-quarters of a mile after rallying to finish 2nd in her 5-furlong debut vs state-bred competition. Trainer Gustavo Delgado has Edgard Zayas returning on the daughter of Gone Astray. **11 LULI'S DANCER** is wheeling back after finishing 3rd again when stretching out from 5 to 6 furlongs last out. Armando De La Cerda hopes J.C. Diaz Jr can get the daughter of Tapiture out of 3rd gear. **12 DEAR MAMA MIA** is stepping up, and stretching out, after pressing the pace and finishing 3rd in her screw tightening debut vs \$50,000 maidens going 5 furlongs. Carlos David has Angel Arroyo handling the outside post.

SELECTIONS: 1-11-12

RACE 9:

1 HEIR BALL, a 7-time winner at the distance, and a 4-time local turf winner, moved to the Jorge Delgado barn via the claim, and is making her first start since coming up empty at this level during May. The barn, 32% with new claims, has the hard-knocking 7-year-old mare training forwardly for the return.

9 DAHLONEGA is going back to her best surface after highlighting her versatility when she defeated this level of competition in a race moved from the turf to 5 furlongs on the dirt. Emisael Jaramillo rides the 4-time turf winner. **7 THINKIN COWTOWN**, a previous stakes winner at the distance, is dropping to the \$12,500 level after going off form when facing tougher here last winter. Trainer Georgina Baxter, who also has dangerous R Next Roll sitting on the also eligible list, is 5 for 14 (36%) with the 180 days-plus layoff.

SELECTIONS: 1-9-7

RACE 10:

4 PATRICK'S LASS moves to the Reuben Gracida barn via the claim, drops to the \$20,000 level, after finishing a prompt-the-pace 3rd vs a solid group of \$25,000 starter optional claimers last out. Miguel Vazquez handles the stretchout to 6 ½ furlongs.

5 BETWEEN DREAMS is stepping up the competition after notching her 4th consecutive victory and her 5th win from 6 races thus far, when defeating \$12,500 claimers last out. Trainer Reynaldo Richards, who claimed her 2 starts back, has Samy Camacho atop the amazing daughter of Super Saver.

10 SWEET BABY RAELENN is freefalling to this level after following the 2nd place finish vs \$75,000 optional claimers 2 starts back with a clunker in the \$75,000 Game Face. Jorge Delgado has go-to jock Chantal Sutherland handling the class relief.

SELECTIONS: 4-5-10

RACE 11:

5 EARNESTINE N HAZEL (IRE) is dropping to the \$16,000 level after returning from the layoff to finish a rallying 3rd vs \$25,000 maidens going a mile on a good turf. Saffie Joseph Jr has Edgard handling the 2nd start off the bench. **11 KARENVILLE** is turning back to 7 ½ furlongs after tracking the pace and finishing 2nd vs this level of opposition going a mile and a sixteenth on a good turf. Armando De La Cerda has Samy Camacho handling the turnback. **4 TOURING EGYPT**, now in the Juan C Avila barn, the \$160,000 daughter of Cairo Prince wheels back for the new connections after responding to a dropdown with a 3rd place finish vs \$16,000 maidens going a mile.

SELECTIONS: 5-11-4

BEST BET: RACE 5 – 3 KARTANO

LONGSHOT: RACE 4 – 5 DIMENNA
