



# RACE BY RACE ANALYSIS

## RACE 1:

**3 HIGH GLORY** moves to the Saul Matos barn via the claim, and stretches out to 6 ½ furlongs, after tracking the pace and finishing 3<sup>rd</sup> – as the favorite – behind repeat winner Acting Lucky going 5 ½ furlongs last out. **5 SCIENCE** will try 6 ½ furlongs after rallying wide to finish a distant 2<sup>nd</sup> going three-quarters of a mile vs similar last out.

**9 G T'S BLUE SQUALL** is another trying more distance after back-to-back distant 4<sup>th</sup> place finishes going 5 ½ furlongs.

**SELECTIONS: 3-5-9**

## RACE 2:

**10 DRINKSONTHEBEACH** is a son of Treasure Beach debuting for trainer Laura Cazares with solid turf breeding, and a useful 5-furlong workout on the Palm Meadows turf: Miguel Vazquez rides.

**1 PHARAOH'S PROPHECY**, a son of Pioneerofthe Nile, will be outfitted with blinkers, is moving to the grass, and dropping to the \$25,000 level, after failing to show much in a special weight affair moved from the turf to the dirt. Trainer Mike Maker is 18% with similar class drops.

**5 NIGHT JUMPER** is a son of Amira's Prince debuting for Kent Sweezey with some solid workouts showing at Palm Meadows: Edgard Zayas handles the 2-turn turf debut.

**SELECTIONS: 10-1-5**

## RACE 3:

**1 BEYOND HEAVENLY** is dropping to the \$6,250 level, and turning back to a sprint distance, after her 2-race win streak vs a notch tougher ended when she finished a distant 3<sup>rd</sup> going a mile on a sealed sloppy track last out. Louie Rousell III has Emisael Jaramillo handling the turnback.

**3 DINNER AT FIVE** is making her first start since she dueled for the lead and finished 2<sup>nd</sup> behind repeat winner Between Dreams going 6 ½ furlongs vs similar during June. Trainer Gilberto Zerpa has Miguel Vazquez handling the return.

**4 BIONIC BOTTLE** is making her local return the first start since shipping up to Tampa and defeating \$8,000 '2-lifetime' claimers as the odds-on choice: Samy Camacho goes for 2 in a row.

**SELECTIONS: 1-3-4**

## RACE 4:

**5 QUIET STRENGTH** is hoping to get away trouble free after tossing her head at the start causing her to break last in a field of 9, prior to closing to finish 4<sup>th</sup> at this level and distance. Ed Plesa Jr has Hector Berrios penciled in for the return riding assignment. **2 FLYING BLACK** is stepping up, and stretching out, after rallying along the inside to come with a neck of exiting the \$12,500 maidens ranks going 7 ½ furlongs on the turf. Victor Barboza Jr is 22% with the 2<sup>nd</sup> start back from a 45-180 days layoff. **3 PANOTTI** is stretching out slightly to a mile after rallying late to finish 5<sup>th</sup> – beaten less than 2 lengths – vs \$16,000 maidens going 7 ½ furlongs. Kent Sweezey has Miguel Vazquez up.

**SELECTIONS: 5-2-3**

## RACE 5:

**9 DOMINANT JOY** is dropping to the \$25,000 level on the dirt after breaking from the outside, racing wide, and never being able to overcome that deficit when finishing 9<sup>th</sup> vs special weight runners going 7 ½ furlongs on the turf. Saffie Joseph Jr is 41% with similar class drops, 30% with the turf to dirt move, and 25% with the route to sprint angle. **4 MISS INEZ** is a daughter of Klimt (Quality Road) debuting for trainer Terri Pompay with a solid work tab showing: Edgard Zayas rides. **12 OUR ELECTRA GUITAR** is a daughter of Star Guitar (Quiet American) debuting for trainer Carlos David, who is 21% with his first-time starters. Emisael Jaramillo will handle the demanding outside post.

**SELECTIONS: 9-4-12**



**RACE 6:**

**10 HALCYON DIGEST** is dropping to the \$12,500 level after setting the pace and weakening to finish 4<sup>th</sup> vs \$20,000 conditioned claimers going 7 ½ furlongs. Trainer David Fawkes has Emisael Jaramillo rationing his speed when going a mile and a sixteenth this time out.

**8 EXPRESS PHAROAH** is another stretching out to 8 ½ furlongs after rallying from a tough outside post – as the favorite – to finish 2<sup>nd</sup> vs this level of competition going 7 ½ furlongs. The son of American Pharoah is bred to love the added distance. **4 MAJORITY RULES** is a candidate for a rebound performance at a price after following the solid \$16,000 maiden victory going a mile with a slow starting wide trip going 7 ½ furlongs last out.

**SELECTIONS: 10-8-4**

**RACE 7:**

**7 PALOMITA**, now in the David Fawkes barn, the mare cuts back to a sprint distance after finishing 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> in 5 consecutive allowance races before going to the sidelines in December. The \$225,000 daughter of Into Mischief has Emisael Jaramillo handling the return. **3 LORILOUPIES** is back in the allowance optional claiming ranks after breaking slowly and never getting untracked when finishing 8<sup>th</sup> and last in the \$75,000 Musical Romance. Saffie Joseph Jr has Edgard Zayas named to ride. **4 AWESOME ANNMARIE** has been knocking on the door in back-to-back 6 furlongs sprints at this level. Trainer Herbert Miller has Rajiv Maragh the stretchout to 6 ½ furlongs.

**SELECTIONS: 7-3-4**

**RACE 8:**

**2 BUENISIMO** is stretching out slightly to a mile after rallying to finish 2<sup>nd</sup> – beaten a nose – vs similar going 7 ½ furlongs. The Juan C Avila trainee has Hector Berrios at the controls.

**4 THENORTHREMEMBERS** is stepping up, and stretching out to 8 furlongs, after returning from the layoff to finish 2<sup>nd</sup> vs \$12,500 claimers going 7 ½ furlongs. His recent speed figure indicates he can compete at this level.

**1 GUNMAN** will depart from the rail after setting the pace and weakening late when finishing 3<sup>rd</sup> vs this level of competition going 7 ½ furlongs. Trainer Padarath Lutchman has Marcos Meneses playing catch me if you can.

**SELECTIONS: 2-4-1**

**RACE 9:**

**6 GLORY OF FLORIDA** is going back to the main track after following a pair of well-meant performances vs this caliber of competition going a mile on the dirt with a troubled starting 6<sup>th</sup> on the turf in the \$75,000 Mr Steele. Laura Cazares has Miguel Vaquez up. **5 COOL ARROW** is stretching out to one of his best distances (6-3-0-0) after finishing an even 3<sup>rd</sup> vs \$50,000 optional claimers going 6 ½ furlongs in the slop last out. Trainer Terri Pompay is 29% with the 2 sprints to a route angle. **7 QUENANE** is a hard-knocking 10-time local winner who can jump and beat this level of competition on any given day. You can never leave the 13-time winner at the distance out of your plans.

**SELECTIONS: 6-5-7**

**RACE 10:**

**2 HERE COMES BULLET** is stepping up to the next level after following his \$12,500 maiden victory with an impressive score vs \$6,250 '2-lifetime' claimers last out. Trainer Victor Barboza Jr has Edgard Zayas going for the 3<sup>rd</sup> straight score at a mile. **11 EXCALIBUR** moved to the Jorge Delgado barn via the claim after drawing clear late to defeat \$6,250 '2-lifetime' foes going a mile. The barn, 31% with new claims, has Emisael Jaramillo in the saddle. **8 GUACO** is dropping to this level on the main track after prompting the pace and fading late vs \$10,000 conditioned claimers going a mile and a sixteenth on the turf. The barn is 2 for 7 (29%) with the grass to dirt angle.

**SELECTIONS: 2-11-8**

**BEST BET: RACE 9 – 6 GLORY OF FLORIDA**

**LONGSHOT: RACE 4 - 5 QUIET STRENGTH**
